

# Moreland City Council is working to improve access across the municipality.

## Access Issues

Council through its annual works program can address access and safety issues by:

- Repairing damaged footpaths
- Addressing unsafe road/street crossings
- Unblocking footpaths (e.g. incorrect street trading or footpaths blocked by construction and/or rubbish dumping)
- Installing tactile indicators
- Installing adequate lighting on streets and paths
- Providing seating and shelter near bus stops
- Advocating for sufficient traffic light time at pedestrian crossings

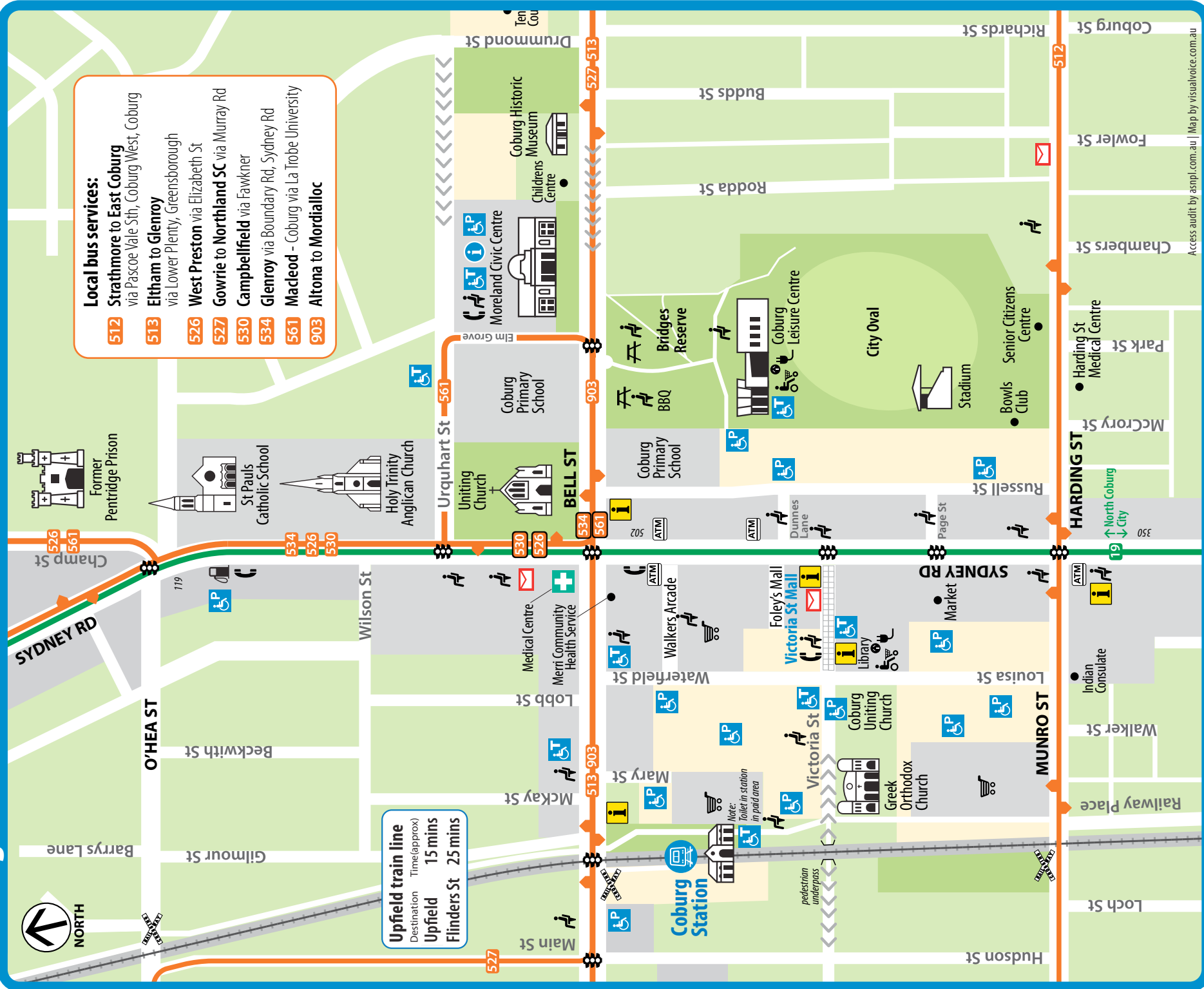
