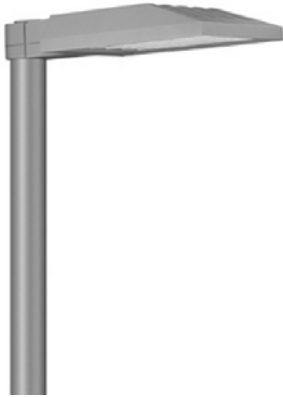

# Coburg Street Lighting B160.04

## DESIGN STATEMENT

Street lighting should be used in all other vehicle based streets other than Sydney Road and civic spaces within Coburg activity centre.

Multiple lights per pole and varied lighting angles should be considered within shared spaces. LED light provides improved energy efficiency.

## STANDARD SPECIFICATION

**Type:** PFL240 LED luminaires from WE-EF.

**Size:** Size of the fixture will need to be confirmed with Council depending on the height of the pole.

**Colour:** Metallic grey.

**Pole Colour:** Metallic grey to match the colour of fixture.

**Height:** minimum 5m, depending on design requirement.
