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# Standard Turf Specification C100.02

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## DESIGN STATEMENT

Turf is an effective ground cover which reduces run-off, erosion and help retain water in the soil.

Use of turf in nature strips adds to the greenery to the street and create provide a residential character. Use of turf in parks provide a ground area for picnic and creates a cooling effect.

Primarily comprising temperate zone grass such as Kikuyu, generally oversown with a winter Rye, it has minimal maintenance in that it requires only mowing and, in certain locations, supplemental irrigation in summer.

**Open Space Maintenance:** For parks, water newly planted grass periodically as required. Replace dead patches and remove weeds.

**Property Owners:** Turf on nature strips are maintained by property owners which includes mowing, watering and weeding. Change of grass to granitic sand may be allowed in some areas where it does not contradict Moreland Street Landscaping Strategy, contact Open Space Design and Development for further information.

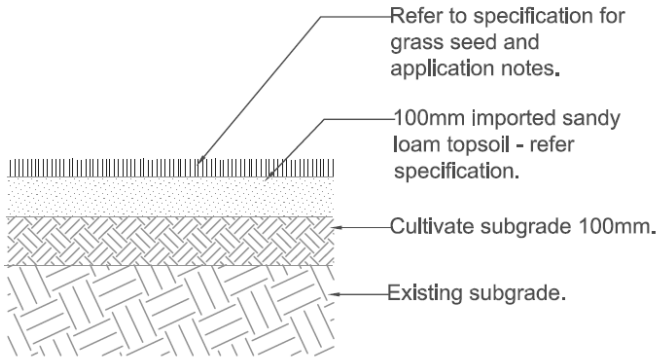
## GENERAL NOTES

*Hydroseeding:*

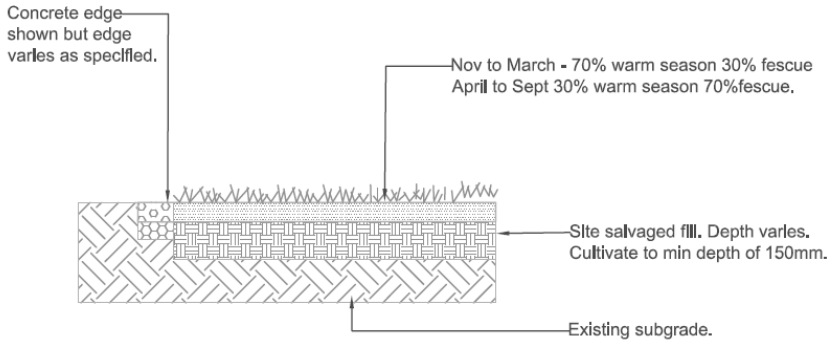
1. Fill with site salvaged soil and grade lawn area to levels indicated.
2. Remove all weeds and undesirable plants as specified two weeks prior to planting.
3. Remove any surface rubble or rock with diameter >25mm.
4. Top dress - 100mm depth imported topsoil. Topsoil sample to be provided.
